Description

The Broadcom® BCM53547 switch family offers industry-leading integration and low power in a small footprint. The device offers up to 24GbE ports and four 2.5G uplink ports. Offering the industry's highest level of integration, the BCM53547 has embedded copper GPHYs as well as a powerful Arm Cortex-A9 processor. The BCM53547 is ideal for cost-sensitive edge applications such as L2/L3 Smart-managed wiring closet switches for enterprise or MTU/MDU switches for service providers.

The BCM53547 family offers I/O configurations that address key segments of Edge connectivity. A single device supports the popular 24x GbE switch with 4x 2.5G uplinks.

IEEE 802.11ac Wave2 increases the data rate required by access points from GbE to 2.5GbE. The BCM53547 provides up to four of the 24 ports to be multirate, enabling the development of cost-effective platforms that support both Gigabit connections for the desktop as well as 2.5G for access points.

The BCM53547 device family builds on the successful BCM53344 and features EEE for low power, IEEE 802.1Q VLAN, VLAN translation, enhanced Denial-of-Service (DoS) protection, IPv4 and IPv6 support, advanced ContentAware[™] Engine, IEEE 802.1p Quality-of-Service (QoS), and HiGig-Lite[™] stacking. New features in this generation include priority flow control, and IEEE 802.1br port extender support.


