





Figure 1. Static Characteristic

Figure 2. DC Current Gain




Figure 3. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage




Figure 4. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage




Figure 5. Resistive Load Switching Time




Figure 6. Inductive Load Switching Time




Figure 7. Forward Bias Safe Operating Area




Figure 8. Reverse Bias Safe Operating Area





Figure 9. Power Derating
