





Figure 6. Input Voltage vs. Output Current




Figure 11. Input Voltage vs. Output Current

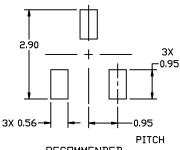

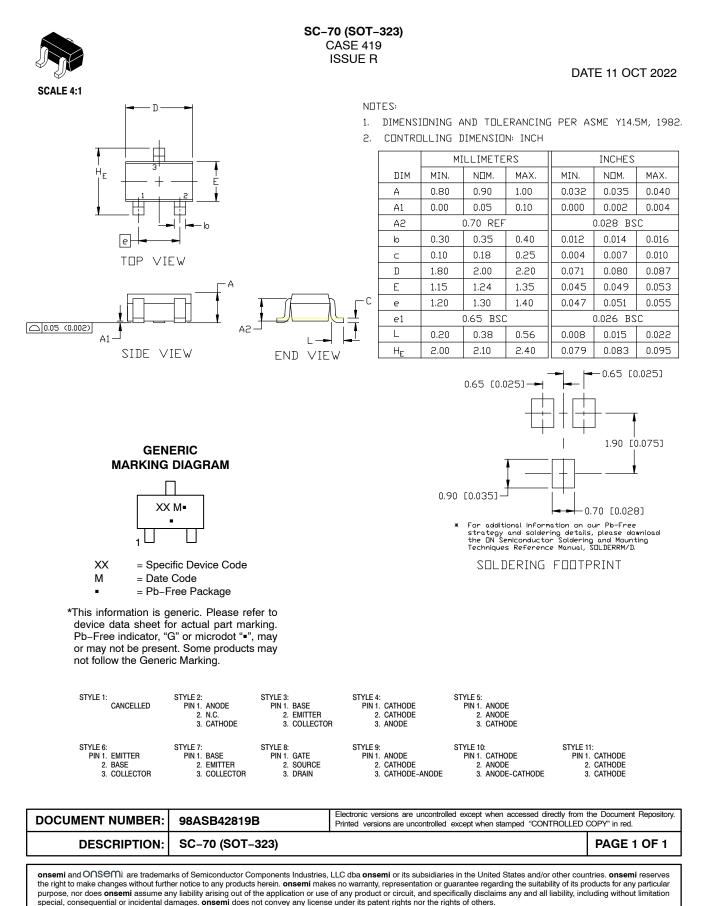

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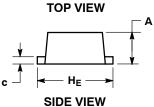
